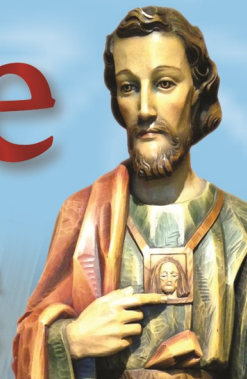

LOW GLUTEN ALTAR BREADS

I am finding out that there are several parishioners who have a celiac condition and cannot receive Holy Communion from a regular Host. People who have this condition suffer severe reactions from foods with a high gluten content.

We have low gluten altar breads that are also consecrated at Mass for those with a celiac condition. A few people have already been benefitting from this accommodation.

If you would like to receive a low-gluten Communion Host, then come up in Communion line on the choir side of the church. Also, let us know beforehand who you are. Call the office to register your name and phone number. If you are not pictured in the recent photo directory, send a note with your photo so we can identify you. One can also avoid receiving a Communion Host and receive only from the cup. The center aisle-north side will be the designated aisle to receive a low gluten Communion Host.

You are asked to tithe 8% of your income. Kindergarten Parents: students MUST have a KCI (Kansas Certificate of Immunization) to start school. No student will be able to start school without a current KCI. Please take time to fill out the forms for free and reduced lunches. They will be available with Mrs. McKinney & Mrs. Thomas. We can get government rebates to help our school based on the number eligible. If you would like to donate used uniforms, you may drop them off in the school office before July 25th. **July 8, 2018 - "Who are You Following?"**
